The Rotary Club of York's Charitable Endowment Fund Grant application is now available online at <http://www.yorkrotary.org/Forms/aspx> (See Forms and Documents; Charitable Endowment Fund Grant Application). You may need to "enable editing" to use the electronic version. Foxit Reader allows you to save complete form but Adobe Reader does not. If you are awarded a grant, the Post Grant Report must be completed within 30 days of completion of the grant but no later than November 30, 2017.

- Grant requests should be between \$2000 - \$10,000, and under special circumstances, we will consider requests up to \$15,000.
- You must itemize your program expenses (supplies, equipment, transportation, etc.).
- The grant must directly impact children and youth of York County.
- The application must include a statement of how the project will be sustained after the grant money has been expended.
- The application must include the current fiscal year's Income & Expense statement.
- New, innovative and/or creative programs/projects and those with opportunity for parental involvement in the project/program will be given favorable consideration

The area of focus for grants awarded in the 2016-17 Rotary year is "**EARLY EDUCATION**" for **programs and projects that directly impact children up to, but not including, 1st grade.** We recognize this is a broad category but we are looking for creative and innovative applications in this focus area which support disabled, handicapped, disadvantaged, and abused children in our area.

The committee does not fund salaries, stipends, capital campaigns, or overhead expenses. An organization may submit only one grant application. The allocation committee reviews grant applications and recommends recipients to the Board of Directors for the distribution of funds.

If your organization meets the criteria and wishes to apply, please complete the application and return it with the required additional documentation to the Rotary office **before February 28.** FINALISTS will be selected and representatives from those organizations will be invited to an interview with the committee to provide additional information about the project. All applicants will be notified of the committee's selection no later than April 30th. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
